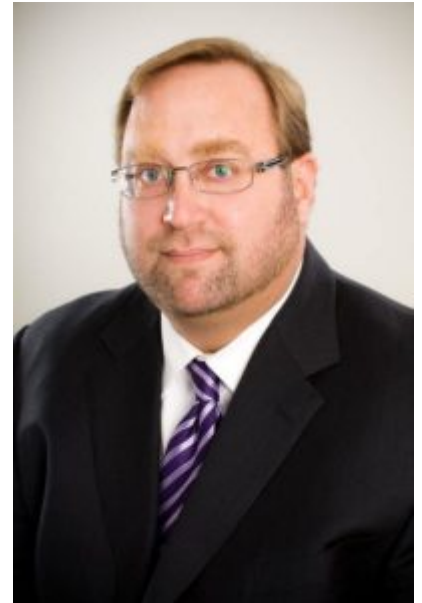


# 5/1/15 – Matt Wilson and Committee Celebrate workers' Comp Centennial
